ATTENTION EXHIBITOR:

Entry fee is \$28 for the first entry of each dog, & \$18 for each additional entry of the same dog. The fee includes the 50-cent AKC Recording Fee and a \$3.00 Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog. Entries close at 6:00 p.m. CST Wednesday, August 26, 2009, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees & signatures & must be on approved entry forms with the agreement on the reverse side. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club & paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only.” (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 15, Section 2).

Classification: Regular Classes - Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B

Classification: Non-Regular Classes - Versatility, Veterans, Brace Novice

Dogs may enter a non-regular class, in addition to a regular class, if desired.

The Veteran’s Class is for dogs that have an obedience title & are at least seven (7) years old by the date of the obedience trial. The exercises will be performed & judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in Veteran’s Class may be entered in another class or classes.

The Versatility Class is for dogs that are capable of performing the Utility exercises that are eligible under the Obedience Regulations. Six exercises will be performed: two each from the Novice, Open, & Utility classes, except there will be no group exercises. The classes will be performed & judged as in the regular classes. However, Scent Discrimination Articles Number 1 & Number 2 will be considered as a single Utility exercise.

The Brace Novice Class features two dogs shown at the same time by one exhibitor, performing exercises as in the Novice Class. One dog must be from member’s family. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled.

Judging of dogs in catalog order will begin promptly at the hour appointed. Dogs are numbered consecutively in each class, with a starting & ending number shown. The dogs are numbered so that the handler may estimate the approximate time he or she will be called by allowing, 8, 7, & 6 dogs per hour in Novice, Open, & Utility, respectively; but the handler must be at ringside well before the calculated time in case absentees or other conditions should advance the schedule. Judges are not required to wait for dogs, & it is the responsibility of each contestant to be ready with his or her dog at ringside, when required, without waiting to be called. Judges may judge dogs entered in more than one class in other than catalog order but cannot be asked to wait. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused after they have been judged.

All prizes must be picked up at the trial. None will be mailed. Only those in regular classes will be eligible for awards. When there is a double entry of the same dog, only the highest score will be eligible for the special awards.

Move-ups are allowed. Please note that Jump Height is NEEDED for classes. Use Rally Box on Entry Form.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and, if this entry is for an Obedience Trial, the "Obedience Regulations" have been made available to me(us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree to hold the AKC and any AKC approved judge harmless from any legal claim resulting from said AKC judge's action under the AKC Rules, Regulations, and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or injury, to be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety). If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class). Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which the entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
