Intermediates: For dogs that are ready for more control exercises, traps and starting off leash control.

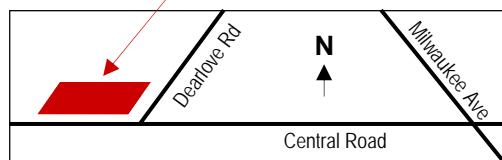
Advanced Intermediate: Off leash on advance courses. Must have full off leash control and previous agility experience.

Class Rules:

1. Walk your dog to the "Duty Area" East end of the field prior to class.
2. You are responsible for the behavior of your Dog at all times. Dogs must be on leash when waiting their turn. Aggression toward people or other dogs is not acceptable could be cause for dismissal.
3. Do NOT under any circumstances let your dog urinate on any of the equipment.
4. If there is an accident and your dog potties on any part of the field, immediately clean it up thoroughly, so other dogs don't follow suit.
5. Choke collars and prong collars during agility are not to be used. For safety reasons, flat buckle collars and leashes or loopless tabs are best.
6. Absolutely no abusive behavior toward any dog, handler or instructor will be tolerated.

Bring to Class:

1. Proof of current inoculations
2. Buckle collar & nylon or leather leash
3. Water and dish for drinking
4. Lots of small treats and/or favorite toy

If classes are canceled they will be rescheduled the following week. There are no refunds for missed classes.
